Loving God with your actions

- ❑ List ways that God has shown his faithfulness in your life. In what ways has he shown his faithfulness despite your failings?
- ❑ Now through the Holy Spirit we have the ability to know, obey and proclaim God in our lives.
 - ❑ Know- Make sure to take time out of your week in prayer and in scripture to get to know God better. Write down characteristics of God and how he has shown Himself in your life.
 - ❑ Obey- Allow the Spirit to move you this week through prayer towards what God is calling you to do in your life.
 - ❑ Help a neighbor in need, volunteer in a ministry in the church, ask God to reveal sin issues that you need to repent of. Whatever it may be, take steps of obedience this week.
 - ❑ Proclaim- Challenge yourself to share with someone how God has proven His faithfulness in your life.

Loving God with your heart

- ❑ Exodus 34:6-7 is a profound revelation of God's character, and is repeated several times in the Old Testament. What kind of emotions do you feel when you read this passage? Are your feelings about verse 6 and verse 7 the same? Why or why not?

- ❑ These words evoked worship from Moses (verse 8). Spend time praising God in song, speech, or writing. Praise Him for his character, specifically for what is revealed here.
- ❑ Exodus 19:5-6 describes God's people as a Kingdom of priests. Priests intercede between God and mankind. Intercede in prayer for the lost.

Loving God with your mind

- God repeats the idea of dwelling with His people many times in the Bible (Ex. 29:45-46, 1 Kings 6;12-13, Jer. 11:4, 30:22, Ezek. 36:26-28, 2 Cor. 6:16, Rev. 21:3.) List ways that God dwelling with us in Christ is now far superior to the old covenant.
- Look at the idea of the Mountain of God in Exodus 19:10-25, Hebrews 12 and Revelation 21. What has changed between Exodus and now? What will change in the future?
