- ❖ What are some important principles/takeaways that you see after observing this text?

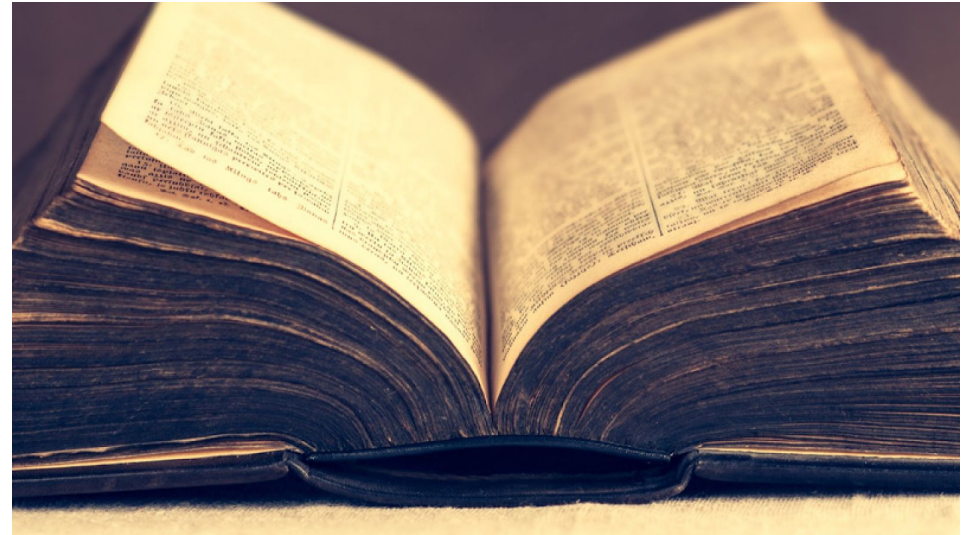
