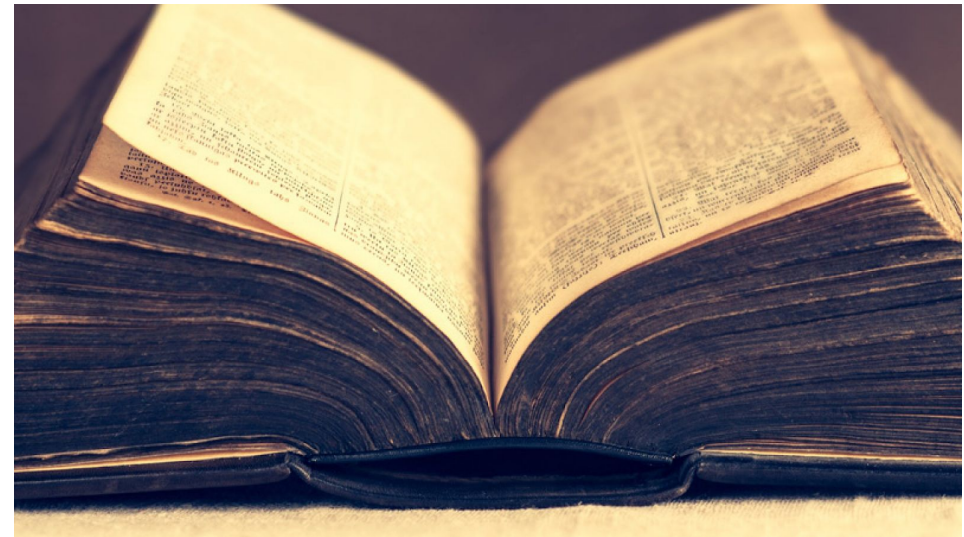


- ❖ Read Judges 17:6 and 21:25. Why is everything such a moral mess in Israel according to the author?
